
Objective:


- Teaching-Learning Process




5. What degree program are you pursuing now 429 responses




6. What subject area are you currently pursuing 429 responses




7. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class $429\,\mathrm{responses}$




8. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes 429 responses




9. How well were the teachers able to communicate 429 responses



10. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 429 responses




11. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 429 responses




















