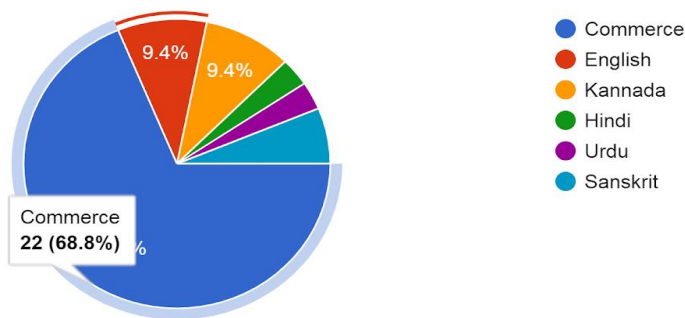


# TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM - IV

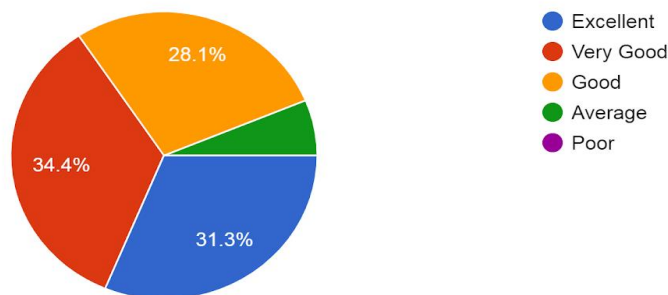

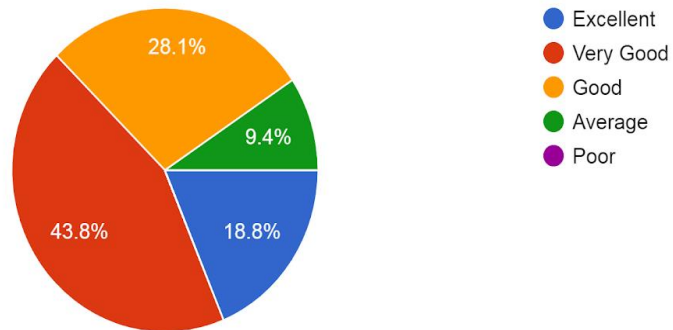
## 1.Syllabus is suitable to the course?

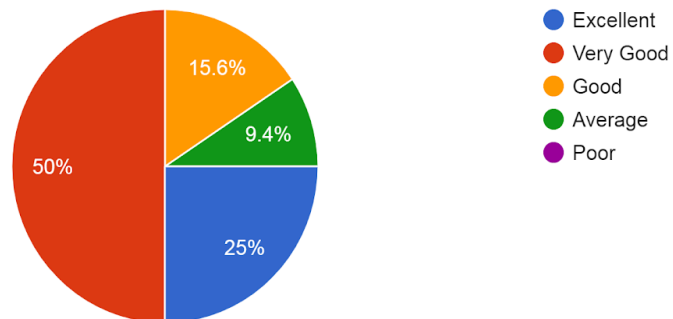
## 2. Syllabus is need based?

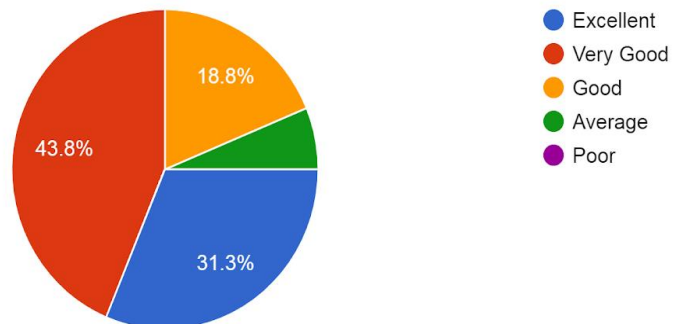
## 3. Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students?

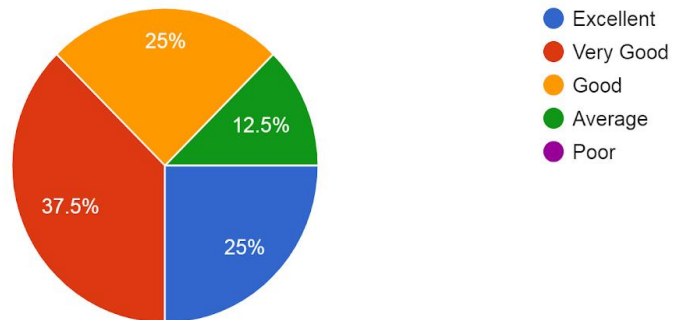

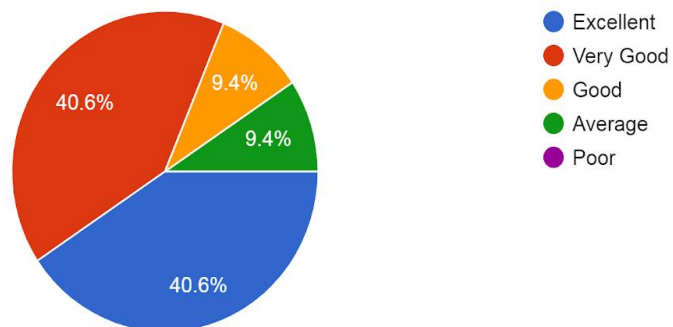
5.The course/syllabus has good balance between theory and Lab?

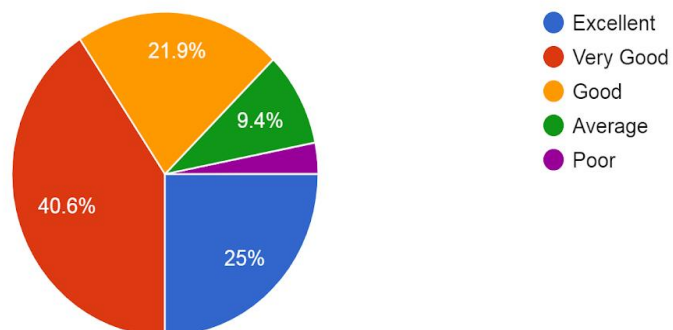

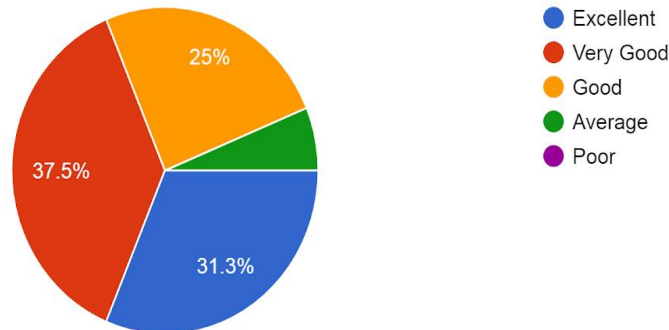
